The Dean's Corner

April 1, 1987

Dear alumni and friends,

Once again you and the other graduates of the Law School have set a record in financial support for your school. The totals are now in for the 1986 fund-raising year. Our receipts exceeded, for the first year ever, *one million dollars!*


Of the \$1,004,000 total, some \$830,000 was earmarked by contributors for the new law building, as many of you paid in full your pledges to that project. An additional \$174,000 was designated for the Annual Fund, and will be used for research, scholarships, and support of student and faculty activities during 1987.

The 1986 total is extraordinary, and represents nearly a 50 percent increase over the 1985 total of \$674,000. All of the faculty and students join me in expressing our sincere thanks for this tremendous showing of support.

Since many of you have given generously to the new law building, I would like to update you on its construction. The total cost of the project is budgeted at \$17.5 million, which will include not only the construction contract, but also the necessary furniture, fixtures, equipment and landscaping.

Private contributions by our alumni and friends will make up \$2.6 million of the project cost, and will allow us to have a working environment that is first-rate in every way. For example, we will be able to purchase new furniture, and will need to move very little of our present furniture, which is in quite shabby condition, from Tate Hall to the new building. We will also have a fine computer system, excellent trial practice and moot court facilities, and all of the physical ingredients needed to support our program.

Now let me turn to a brief progress report on the building. As this is being written, concrete is being poured for the walls of the subplaza level. The building has four levels, three above the grade line or plaza and one below grade. (There is actually a sub-subplaza-level room at the northwest corner of the building, but it is strictly for equipment and utility access.) The subplaza level will contain all of the classrooms, the student lounge and locker areas, offices for the student organizations, and the lowest



level of the law library, which will be used primarily for storage.

The classrooms will have slightly sloping tiers of seats, and the concrete for the tiers will be poured soon. In addition, concrete columns that will support the plaza level are being poured.

The entire building is supported by these concrete columns, which are spaced on a grid at 27-foot intervals on all levels. The columns are reinforced by steel. First the steel reinforcing rods are erected and tied together. Then a cylindrical form, which looks much like the cardboard tube from a roll of paper towels, is dropped over the reinforcing and supported by temporary braces. Next, concrete is poured into the tube. When it has hardened, the tube is unwrapped, leaving the finished column in place.

If you are in or near Columbia, please drop by to visit me and view the progress of the construction. I think you'll find it fascinating. At the northwest corner of the site is a sample of the brick facing that will be used on the building. It closely matches the color of Tate Hall and Jesse Hall. Thus the new law building will form an architectural unity with these existing "red campus" buildings.

We plan to move into the new building in the summer of 1988. Heavy rains last fall placed the project a few weeks behind schedule, but the contractor expects to make up most of this time. The winter weather was excellent, and only a few days were lost due to snow. By next winter, of course, the project will be under roof and the weather will no longer present a serious hazard.

If all goes well, we expect to have a dedication ceremony for the building in August of 1988, just prior to the beginning of the fall semester. Thus, our present first-year students will be able to spend their third year in the new building, and those who enter in the fall of 1987 will spend two years there.

I hope you'll mark your calendar tentatively for the last week in August, 1988, and plan to be present for the building dedication. I believe you'll be pleased and excited to see how your contributions have made such a fine facility possible.


James E. Westbrook was selected to receive a Faculty-Alumni Award based on accomplishments in the legal



Grant S. Nelson







Serve as Bar Leaders









Susan D. Csaky published Part Five of "A Collection of Trials on Microfiche." She attended the annual meetings of the Mid-America Association of Law Libraries in St. Louis and the Association of American Law Schools in Los Angeles.

Peter N. Davis presented a speech on "Missouri Water Rights Legislation" for the Water Resources Seminar at the University of Missouri-Columbia Engineering College. He also spoke at the Soybean Growers and Irrigation Conference on "Missouri State Water Legislation Update." He has provided testimony on House Bill 207, Missouri Environmental Policy Bill, before the Missouri House committee on energy and environment and testimony on House Bill 238, Missouri Diffused Surface Water Use Bill, before the Missouri House agriculture committee. He has drafted revisions to faculty regulations for the Faculty Council concerning: dismissal of tenured faculty; proposed University of Missouri Faculty Misconduct Regulations; and Composition of University of Missouri-Columbia promotion and tenure committee. Carl H. Esbeck edited a book called "Religious Beliefs, Human Rights and the Moral Foundation of Western Democracy" to be published by the Missouri University Press. He also wrote a chapter for Pilgrim Press' book "Government Intervention in Religious Affairs" called "The Establishment Clause: Assuring the Independence of Churches in a Neutral State." David A. He is Vice-Chair of the Tort Liability Study Committee. This is a special committee of the Torts and Insurance Practice Section of the ABA. Its purpose is to study and report on proposed changes in tort law. He is a member of the Editorial Board of the "Products & Services Compliance Report".

William B. Fisch attended the XII International Congress of Comparative Law in Australia. He presented a paper on "Judicial Use of Personal Knowledge." Along with James Devine, he has published a "Teachers Manual on Professional Responsibility."

William F. Fratcher has completed the 1986 supplement to "Scott on Trusts". He also has published Volumes I and IA, fourth edition, of "Scott on Trusts". He is researching a manuscript for the 1987 supplement to "Scott on Trusts". Volumes 2 and 2A of "Scott on Trusts" are now in page proof and Volume 3 is being researched by Professor Fratcher. He is Visiting Professor of Law, Western New England College School of Law in Springfield, Massachusetts for the 1986-87 year.

Timothy J. Heinsz is researching an article called "Judicial Review of Arbitration Awards." He presented a speech on "The Arbitration Process: Views of the Arbitrator" to the Missouri Bar Association, labor law section, and a speech on "How to Win an Arbitration" to the American Arbitration Association in Cincinnati. Edward H. Hunvald, Jr. is working on a substantive criminal law text for the West Missouri Practice Series. He participated as a criminal law professor in the Criminal Law Elections Office summer program and continues to chair the criminal law committee for the Multistate Bar Examination. He was a member of the committee that drafted the Missouri Approved Instructions-Criminal, third edition.

Michael Middleton is researching an article on "The Constitutional Tension Between Liberty and Equality: Race Consciousness in Governmental Decisionmaking," and an article on "Subjectivity and Title VII." He has given several speeches including: "Balancing the Scales: 200 Years After the Constitution, Future Designs for Educational Equality, A National Conference on School-Equality"; "Current Constitutional Issues" at the ACLU annual membership meeting; "Affirmative Action and the Constitutional Ideal of Equality" for the American Bar Association National Legal Research Education Leadership Seminar; and "Expert Witnessing" for the College of Engineering and School of Law workshop. 

Terry has written several books, law review articles and Missouri Bar Continuing Legal Education publications on tort law, products liability and medical malpractice in the United States and England.

Moseley Receives Thomas D. Cochran Award

Law School Alumnus Joe Moseley ('76) has received the Thomas D. Cochran Community Service Award for volunteer work outside the legal profession. Moseley is the national president of the Mizzou Alumni Association, president of the University's Quarterback Club, president elect of the Columbia Downtown Rotary, chairman emeritus of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society and vice president of the Sigma Nu House Corp. He also serves on the board of directors of the Community Council on Child Abuse and the Rainbow House Children's Center, the Board of Governors of the Eye Research Foundation, and the advisory council for the Law Enforcement Training Institute. The Cochran Community Service Award is presented each year to a Missouri lawyer by the Young Lawyers section of the Missouri Bar Association.



Bob Bailey Returns to Law School

Robert G. Bailey ('79) resigned as municipal judge for the city of Columbia Feb. 16, 1987, to return to the University of Missouri-Columbia School of Law as its assistant dean. Bailey had served as municipal judge for the past three and one-half years while also working part-time as the Law School's academic counselor. He will be primarily responsible for alumni and development relations.

Besides his Law School duties, Bailey is active in the community. Bailey also serves as an arbitrator on the Federal Mediation and Conciliation, and American Arbitration Association Labor Arbitrator panels.

Smith Receives Pro Bono Award

Columbia attorney Robert C. Smith Jr., a 1949 School of Law graduate, received the Pro Bono Publico Award during the Missouri Bar's 107th annual meeting in late October. The award is presented annually to members of the Missouri Bar who have made significant contributions toward providing low cost or free legal assistance to economically disadvantaged people.

Since 1984, Smith has served as treasurer of the IOLTA Board of the Missouri Bar, which handles earnings of lawyer's trust funds. Fund earnings have supplied more than \$200,000 toward providing legal services to low-income people.

Smith, senior partner in the law firm of Smith, Lewis and Beckett, believes that lawyers have a dual obligation to the public: to make the legal profession as efficient as possible and to help those who cannot afford legal assistance. Smith further emphasizes that during an era when government budget cuts affect legal aid to the poor, lawyers must assume a special responsibility on behalf of others.

In addition to an outstanding record of service to the legal profession, Smith also is active in political, community and University activities. He has served as a member of the Missouri House of Representatives from 1953-57, as mayor of the city of Columbia from 1961-63, and is a current curator of Stephens College and a trustee of the Missouri Law School Foundation.

Smith and his wife, Jean, have four children and two grandchildren.



From the Law Library: New Ways of Searching for a Law Journal Article

Reminiscing about Law School writing assignments, most attorneys will recall the tedious task of finding the law review article that was on point. They perused numerous paper- and hard-bound volumes, scrutinized vague and unsatisfactory subject headings, and laboriously copied each reference in longhand. Yet, despite these efforts, the best article may have escaped attention because the journal in which it was published was not included in the *Index to Legal Periodicals*.

But now there are new ways to scan legal journals both manually and through computer-assisted search.

Manual searches have not changed much in the past decade. The *Index to Legal Periodicals* is still around but somewhat rejuvenated. A committee of experienced law librarians advises the H. W. Wilson Co. on what periodicals and new subject headings to include. Updating the paper copies of the *Index* is as laborious as before, but the *Index* is available on LEXIS and WESTLAW and through a number of gateways to databases such as DIALOG. WILSONLINE, the company's own automated system, is available in only a few law libraries.

A new legal periodical search tool, *Current Law Index*, probably accelerated the revamping of ILP. Developed by the Information Access Corp., the index provides access to more than 700 legal and law-related periodicals. Because of the number of journals covered, better bibliographic information under author and subject, and a more detailed indexing, the American Association of Law Libraries endorsed this index. The association continues to oversee it through one of its committees. The publication format is similar to that of ILP: monthly issues are cumulated into three-monthly and bound volumes. A companion microfilm publication, *Legal Resources Index*, provides monthly cumulative access to the legal periodical literature from 1980 on. The coverage is more extensive, providing references to articles in law reviews, legal newspapers and non-law periodicals. The microfilm reader used with the *Legal Resources Index* does not connect to a printer, so the user must make copious longhand notes. LRI is available, however, on both WESTLAW and LEXIS and through some of the gateways to databases.

But there are some problems with the computer availability of *Index to Legal Periodicals* and *Legal Resources Index*. First, they are costly. Users pay telecommunication and access charges, which average about \$90 an hour. Second, these databases are not available on an educational discount; thus they cannot be used in our Law Library.

However, there is a new and convenient automated system for searching the legal periodical literature, legal newspapers and non-law journals for law-related articles. A product of Information Access Co., it uses an IBM PC, an HP Thinkjet printer and a 12-inch laser disk to access the company's various databases. The system is called *Legal Infotrac*.



Law libraries receive a new laser disk every month, which provides cumulative access to all materials mentioned above from 1980 on.

The system is so simple that even those who have not used a personal computer before can learn it within minutes. Also, because the database is on laser disk, there is no need to communicate with mainframe computers through telephone lines so there is no access or telecommunication charge. And there are no peak, off-peak, or down-times; the system is on at all times. In addition, searching is completed in a matter of seconds, and a tap on the "print" button provides immediate print-out of the references.

Of course, such a convenient system is not inexpensive. The yearly subscription to *Legal Infotrac* is more than \$5,500. Veteran legal database searchers must also remember that this computerized tool is only an indexing system with Library of Congress-style subject headings, and is not responsive to Boolean queries.

Daily is New Academic Counselor

Melody Daily ('86) is serving as the Law School's academic advisor. She also is teaching three sections of advocacy and research.

This summer Daily will direct the Council on Legal Education Opportunity program and teach a writing class. This is the second year that the Law School will host the CLEO Regional Summer Institute.

CLEO provides about 35 minority and disadvantaged college graduates with a preview of law study and an opportunity to prove that they have the ability to succeed in law schools. The six-week summer course draws students from Texas, Oklahoma, Louisiana, Arkansas, Kansas, Nebraska and Missouri.

Since her graduation, Daily has worked with her husband, William J. Daily ('78), an attorney in Glasgow, Mo.



1986 Placement Statistics

Placement Office statistics for the class of 1986 indicate that 97 percent had secured employment as of Feb. 1, 1987. Only 1 percent were still seeking employment and 2 percent chose not to take the July Bar Exam. Some 57 percent are engaged in private practice. Other employment areas are: judicial clerkship, 15 percent; state and federal government, 14 percent; accounting, corporate and insurance, 5 percent; academic, 2 percent; and military, public interest, non-legal and non-traditional, 1 percent each.

National Association for Law Placement 1987-Midwest Conference

Karen Shelton, University of Missouri-Columbia Placement Adviser, and Nancy Corcoran, recruitment administrator for Thompson & Mitchell of St. Louis, coordinated the midwest regional conference of the National Association for Law Placement, which was held in late January. More than 150 representatives from law schools and law firms in a seven-state area attended the three-day conference held at the Adam's Mark Hotel in St. Louis.

Alumni Tom Watkins ('71), and Tom Becker ('74), and third-year student Scott Watson were among eight panelists who discussed "Recruiting Revisited." This was an insightful review of the recruitment process from a student/lawyer point of view.

In addition, several St. Louis and Kansas City firms hosted cocktail buffet receptions at the Adam's Mark and the Omni hotels. Each reception showcased the hosting city.

The National Association for Law Placement supports the interest of all professionals and organizations engaged in placement and recruitment activities. The association formulates and maintains standards and procedures to guide law schools and employers in placement and recruitment activities. Currently, 170 ABA-approved law schools are members.

The University of Missouri-Columbia Placement Office thanks the contributing firms and alumni for their support of the 1987 NALP Midwest Conference.

First-year Interviews Increase

First-year recruitment has increased significantly this past February with more than 10 legal employers scheduled for on-campus interviews. Of these 10, six major firms began a new first-year recruitment program for 1987.

Recruitment programs targeting first-year students reflect a nationwide trend as the larger metropolitan law firms seek to gain a competitive edge in the market for top students.

High salaries and escalating hiring structures are compelling reasons for firms to use a high-profile approach in recruitment.

Although interviewing has increased, the number of first-year students actually securing a summer clerkship remains relatively small when compared with the hiring of second-year law clerks. However, first-year interviewing provides law students an introduction to the legal job market, a chance to sharpen interview skills and the opportunity to begin evaluating long-term career goals.
