The *Missouri Law Review* publishes one volume per academic year. Each volume consists of four issues. Subscriptions are accepted only on a volume basis, starting with the first issue of the volume. Current subscription price: \$40.00 (Foreign subscriptions -- \$45.00). Payment for renewal subscriptions is due within thirty days of the invoice date. Any entity or individual invoiced for four or more renewal subscriptions will be charged \$5.00 per subscription for failure to pay within thirty days. Refunds will not be made for cancellations made after the publication of the first issue of any volume.

Subscribers must report non-receipt of an issue within six months of its mailing or one month of receipt of a succeeding issue, whichever is shorter, in order to receive that issue without additional charge.

All notifications of change of address should include old and new addresses with zip codes. Notice of a change of address must reach the *Review* one month in advance of publication to ensure delivery. The Post Office will not forward issues to a new address.
